

**DECISION OF REGIONAL TRANSPORT AUTHORITY, WAYANAD
MEETING HELD ON 12.07.2023 AT 11.00 AM**

ItemNo.1

Heard. This is an application to reconsider the adjourned application for fresh regular permit to operate on the route Irulam-Kenichira via Ambalappadi, Angadissery, Parappangady, Koleri as ordinary service."As per the enquiry report submitted by the field officer, Irulam, Ambalappadi, Angadissery, Koleri has not been adequately served with stage carriages. The field officer also proposed that the routes are thickly populated. Introduction of the proposed service is highly beneficial to the tribal people, students, employes and other general travelling public. The only objection received is from KSRTC regarding timing objection. **Hence fresh permit granted subject to settlement of timings and production of suitable vehicle within one month from the date of receipt of this decision failing which sanction will be revoked without further notice.**

ItemNo.2

Heard. This is an application for fresh regular permit to operate on the route Thaloor- Sulthan Bathery- via Chuliyode-Madakkara as "ordinary service. "Heard This application was adjourned by the meeting held on 22/06/2022 with the direction to submit the report regarding the overlapping of schemes of KSRTC on the portion Thaloor- Sulthan Bathery. As per the specific report field officer reported that overlapping is not objectionable. The objection received from KSRTC regarding the timings only. **Hence fresh permit is granted subject to settlement of timings and production of suitable vehicle within one month from the date of receipt of this decision failing which sanction will be revoked without further notice.**

ItemNo.3

Heard. This is an application for reconsidering the adjourned for fresh permit on the route Nambiyarkunnu-Bathery-Pulpally- Kalpetta via Cheeral- Thenichira- Eriyapally-Kariyampadi- Kottavayal- Muttil VW hospital- Edappetty-Kainatty-Meenangadi and Madal as ordinary service. Reconsidered. The field officer reported that the route portion from SulthanBathery to Kalpetta is well served. Several objections received from enroute operators including KSRTC stating that introduction of the service on the sector Kalpetta- Sulthan Bathery will badly affect their service. The Head master, GVP school Poothadi and principal S.N.Higher secondary school Poothadi, objected the application saying that granting of this permit may stop their enjoying facility.**So this authority feels that granting of this permit may encourage unnecessary competition among the operators and may lead to accidents and this will be threat to road safety. Hence rejected.**

ItemNo04

"Heard." This is an application for fresh permit to operate on the route Poolakundu- Sulthan Bathery-Kalpetta- via Cheeral-Meenangadi- Parakkal- Kainatty- Kumbalery- Ambalavayal-Chuliyode-Malankara- Malankara Pally and Ammayipaalamas as ordinary service.On verification of the application, it is found that the intention of the applicant is to conduct service on the sector Kalpetta - Sulthan bathery. It is a well-served portion. Several objections received from the existing operators that introduction of this service may leads to unhealthy competition and accidents. The enquiry officer reported violation of GO(P)No19/1986 PW&T on the portion Sulthan bathery, Meenangadi Kainatty. **Hence the application for fresh regular permit rejected.**

ItemNo.05

"Heard". This is an application for fresh regular permit in respect of new or suitable vehicle to operate on the route Poolakundu- S. Bathery - Kalpetta via Cheeral-Meenangadi-Muttil- VW hospital- Edapetty-Kainatty- Kumbileri- Ambalavayal- Chuliyode Malankara-Malankarapally- Ammaipaalam as ordinary service., Verified the application and report of the field officer, the majority of the trips offered is on the sector Kalpetta - Sulthan Bathery. Also the Field officer reported that Kalpetta-SulthanBathery is a well-served sector. During the meeting, several objections received against the application pointing out that introduction of this service will create unhealthy competition and result accidents. **Hence the application for fresh regular permit is rejected.**

Item No 06

“Heard”. This is an application to reconsider the decision of meeting held on 22/06/2022 vide supplementary item No 06. The applicant requested for fresh regular permit to operate on the route Papplassery- Bathery - Pulpally (via) Beenachi, Vakeri, Pazhupathur- Kenichira - Mannalvayal- Eriyapally- Arivayal- CCJunction as ordinary service. Earlier, this application was adjourned with a direction to secretary RTA to conduct a detailed enquiry for submitting a specific report whether there are any overlaps on the route Papplassery- Bathery - Pulpally. Reconsidered, As per the specific report submitted no overlapping in the scheme 42/2009 (modified on 0/2017). The enquiry officer also reported that Sulthan Bathery –beenachi lies in GO(P) No 19/1986 PW&T and the proposed route not touching more than two intermediate points. There is no serious objection except timings. **Hence granted subject to settlement of timings and production of suitable vehicle with in one month from the date of receipt of this decision failing which sanction will be revoked without further notice.**

ItemNo7

“Heard”. This is an application for fresh regular permit in respect of KL157789 or suitable stage carriage to operate on the route S. Bathery - Ayyankoli- S. Bathery via Noolpuzha- pattavayal- Ambalamoola- Mangode- Chuliyode- madakkara as ordinary service applied by MD KSRTC . **Hence, fresh regular stage carriage permit is granted on the above route.**

ItemNo 8

This is an application for fresh regular permit in respect of KL157667 or suitable stage carriage to operate on the route S. Bathery - Ayyankolly- S.Bathery via Noolpuzha- pattavayal- Ambalamoola- Mangode- Chulliode- madakkara as ordinary service. **Hence, fresh regular stage carriage permit is granted on the above route.**

Item No 09

This is an application to consider for fresh regular permit in respect of KL156501 or SuitableStage Carriageto operate on the route **Sulthan Bathery- Ayyankolly- Sulthan Bathery** via Noolppuzha, Pattavayal, Ambalamoola, Mangode, Chulliode, Madakkaraas ordinary service. The application is submitted by MD KSRTC . **Hence, fresh regular stage carriage permit is granted on the above route.**

Item No.10

This is an application for fresh regular permit in respect of KL15 7309 or suitable stage carriage to operate on the route S. Bathery - Ayyankoli- S.Bathery via Noolpuzha- pattavayal- Ambalamoola- Mangode- Chuliyode- madakkara as ordinary service. **Hence, fresh regular stage carriage permit is granted on the above route.**

Item No, 11

This is an application for fresh regular permit in respect of KL15 7482 or suitable stage carriage to operate on the route S. Bathery - Ayyankoli- S. Bathery via Noolpuzha- pattavayal- Ambalamoola- Mangode- Chuliyode-madakkara as ordinary service. **Hence, fresh regular stage carriage permit is granted on the above route.**

ItemNo12

Applicant is absent while the matter is considered. Hence, **decision on the application for fresh regular stage carriage permit is adjourned.** Secretary shall place the application in the next meeting of RTA with due notice to the applicant, indicating the date, time and venue of the meeting.

ItemNo13

This is an application for fresh regular stage carriage permit on the route Kolavally- kalpetta via Seethamound- Padichira- Pulpally- Irulam- Bathery- Kolakaparakavala - Ambalavayal- Narikund- Kadalnad- Arapatta- WIMS hospital- Mepadi- Kappamkoli - and traffic junction Kalpetta and new bus stand Kalpetta as ordinary service. Heard, Considered the application. The enquiry officer reported that the 1.Proposed route is covering the remote areas of Narikkund, Munnoor, Thomath chal and Wims hospital and 2.Vaduvanchal-Kalpetta is well served.3. If it extend the second onwards trip via Thottumchal, Kadanada, Narikkund to Ambalavayal.

The proposed variation offered majority of trips from Vaduvanchal-Kalpetta, a well-served sector compared to the ill served portion. Hence, the applicant is directed to submit a modified set of timing proposal,providing even number of trips to ill-served areas Thottumchal, Kadanada, Narikkund to Ambalavayal. On receipt of such a proposal from the applicant, the secretary, shall conduct an enquiry regarding its feasibility and place the matter before this authority for reconsideration. **For the compliance of the above directions, the decision on the application is adjourned.**

Item No14

Heard. This is an application for fresh regular stage carriage permit in respect of new or suitable stage carriage to operate on the route Kolavally - Kalpetta via Seethamount, Paaclichira, Pulppaly, Irulam, Bathery and traffic in Kalpetta new bus stand Kalpetta as ordinary service. The field officer has recommended to extend the second onward trip to Ambalavayal via Thomattuchal, Kadalmad, Narikund. Narikkund, Munnoor, Thomath chal and Wims hospital. Hence, the applicant is directed to submit a modified set of timing proposal, providing more of trips to ill-served areas Ambalavayal via Thomattuchal, Kadalmad, Narikund. Narikkund, Munnoor, Thomath chal and Wims hospital etc. On receipt of such a proposal from the applicant, the secretary, shall conduct an enquiry regarding its feasibility and place the matter before this authority for reconsideration. **For the compliance of the above directions, the decision on the application is adjourned**

ItemNo15

This is an application for fresh regular permit in respect of new or suitable vehicle to operate on the route Mananthavady-Puthussery-via Pallikkal- Moolithode as ordinary service.

Heard- considered. As per the report of Enquiry officer the proposed route connects ill served areas, Puthussery, Moolithode to Mananthavady. The Enquiry officer recommended the application stating new route is beneficial to students and other passengers. The objections received are regarding the timings. **Hence fresh regular stage carriage permit granted subject to settlement of timings with in one month from the date of receipt of this decision failing which sanction will be revoked without further notice..**

ItemNo16

This is an application for condonation of delay in submitting current records for obtaining fresh permit granted by RTA on 21/12/2021 (vide item no 4) in respect of new or suitable vehicle to operate on the route Perumbadikunnu- Kalpetta- Veniyode via Vaduvanchal, Chelkode, DM Wims, Meepadi, Valathur, Pinagode and muttil as ordinary service. Heard. This permit was granted on 21/12/2021 RTA meeting held on 22/06/2022 dated 22/06/2022 allowed 30 days from the date of receipt of communication of the decision. The applicant failed to produce current records of the vehicle within the stipulated time under rule 159(2) of KMV Rules, 1989. Time elapsed one year since the grant of permit. This request is for condoning delay beyond the purview of KMV Rules, 1989. **Hence request is rejected, the grant of permit is revoked.**

ItemNo17

“Heard,” This is an application for condonation of delay in submitting current records for obtaining fresh permit granted by RTA on 21/12/2021 vide item No3. A fresh stage carriage permit was granted by RTA Wayanad in the meeting held on 21/12/2021 vide item No 3. RTA meeting held on 22/06/2022 vide item additional 30 days allowed. The applicant failed to produce current records of the vehicle with in the stipulated time under rule 19(2) of KMVRules,1989. **Hence, request is rejected the grant of permit is revoked.**

ItemNo18

Applicant is absent while the matter is considered. Hence, **decision on the application for fresh regular stage carriage permit is adjourned.** Secretary shall place the application in the next meeting of RTA with due notice to the applicant, indicating the date, time and venue of the meeting.

ItemNo19

This is an application for fresh permit in respect of new or suitable vehicle to operate on the route Kalpetta- Kavumannam- Mukkamkunnu- S. Bathery- Maniyankode via Pinagode- 8thmile, Idiumavayal, Ozhuthana, Anoth, Parakkal- muttil, Kainatty, VIV hospital, Meenangadi and Munderi as ordinary service. Heard, the enquiry officer reported that there are no much services in the proposed route from Kalpetta to Mukkam kunnu via Muttill, Kalpetta yoldiyamvayal via Kavumannam and route portion from Kalpetta to Sulthan Bathery well served area. During the meeting requested for more trips through ill served area. Considering the report of enquiry officer and demand of public, the applicant is directed to furnish a modified application incorporating more trips via Mukkamkunnu, Idiyam vayal, Mukkankunnu and Maniyankode. On receipt of such a proposal from the applicant, the secretary, shall conduct an enquiry regarding its feasibility and place the matter before this authority for reconsideration. **For the compliance of the above directions, the decision on the application is adjourned.**

ItemNo20

This is an application for fresh regular permit in respect of new or suitable vehicle to operate on the Route **Mukkamkunnu - Meppadi - Muttill** (via) Moopainadu, Nedumbala, Mandad as ordinary service. The enquiry officer reported that the proposed route is through the ill served areas of the district and hence beneficial to the travelling public. The report also added that the route is beneficial to the patients and

employees of Wims Medical College since it is shortest route connecting hospital to Muttill. **Hence the regular permit is granted, subject to settlement of timings and production of current records of suitable vehicle with in one month from the date of receipt of this decision failing which sanction will be revoked without further notice.**

ItemNo.21

This is an application for fresh regular permit in respect of new or suitable vehicle to operate on the Route Pallikkunnu **Basthi - Kambalakkad - Panamaram - Mananthavady** Via Pallikunnu, Varummalkadavu, Pallimukku, Anjukunnu, 6th Mile, Kundala, Kammana, Kurisikal, Karinthirikkadavu, Valliyoorkavu, Koilery Bridge as ordinary service. Heard. Verified the records. The enquiry officer reported that

1)Anjukunnu to 6th Mile 1.2 Km and Panamaram Bridge to Panamaram bus stand 0.3 Km (total 1.5 Kms) lies in 42/2009 and its modified 8/2017, it is below of 5% of total route length.

2)The route is beneficial to the passengers from Kambalakkad to Panamaram Via Pallikkunnu, Eachome, Vilambukandam, Pallimukku, Palukunnu and Mathothpoyil as it is an ill-served area.

3)Proposed route is covering the remote areas of Panamaram and Edavaka Grama Panchayath.

4)There is no much services in the proposed route from 6th mile to Panamaram, Via Pallimukku, Palukunnu and Mathothpoyil and Kurisikal to 6th Mile Via Kammana School, Kammana, Hence new service may be beneficial to the passengers especially students and tribal families of that area.

No serious objections received against this proposal. **Hence Regular permit on the route Pallikunnu Basthi- Kamblakkad - Panamaram- Mananthavady via Pallikunnu, Vaummalkadavu, Pallimukku, Anjukunnu, 6thmile, Kundala, Kammana, Kurisikal, Karinthrikadavu, Valliyoorkavu, Kolery Bridge as ordinary service is granted subject to settlement of timings and production of current records of suitable vehicle with in one month from the date of receipt of this decision failing which sanction will be revoked without further notice.**

ItemNo.22

This is an application for fresh regular permit in respect of new or suitable vehicle to operate on the Route Perikkalloor – Kalpetta –Kalloor - Kallumukku (via) Mullankolly, Pulpally, Irulam, Chethalayam, Sulthan Bathery, Meenangadi, Kainatty, Moolankaavu as ordinary service. **Heard.** Verified therecords. Theenquiry officer reported that in the proposedroute “The distance from Kalpetta to Kainatty 3.4 Km lies in notified sector vide GO(P) No.8/2017 Tran dtd 23.03.2017 Kalpetta to Kalloor 35.9 Km lies in 19/1986 PW&T in Wayanad District and directly touching more than two intermediate points S. Bathery, Meenangadi, Kainatty and Kalpetta”. This is a violation of GO(P)19/1986PW&T scheme modification. **Hence the application for the grant of regular permit on the route Perikkalloor-Kalpetta -Kalloor-Kallumukku is Rejected.**

ItemNo23

This is an application for fresh regular permit in respect of new or suitable vehicle to operate on the Route Muthumari - Mananthavady (via) Pallikkavala, Plamoola, Mullankolly, Kattikkulam as ordinary serviceHeard. Perused the records.The Motor Vehicle Inspector reported that Proposed route is covering the remote tribal colony areas of Kattikkulam, Plamoola, Mullankolly and Muthumary and there are no much services in the proposed route. The officer also added that the new service beneficial to the tribals, students and other passengers. No serious objection raised against the application. **Hence the Regular permit on the route Muthumari Mananthavady (via) Pallikkavala, Plameela, Mullankolly, Kattikulam as ordinary service is granted subject to settlement of timings and production of current records of suitable vehicle within one month from the date of receipt of this decision failing which sanction will be revoked without further notice.**

ItemNo.24

“Heard.” This is an application forthe grant of regular permit on the route Bavali- Mananthavadi- (via) Thonikkadavu, Shanamangalam colony, Palvelichan, Kurukkanmoola, Kattikulam as ordinary service. Records are verified.The enquiry officer reported that the proposed route is an ill-served area and it will be beneficial to the travelling public. No serious objections filed against this application. **Hence Regular permit on the route Bavali- Mananthavadi is granted subject of settlement of timings. Secretary RTA is directed to fix the fare stages in the virgin portion Palvelicham to Thonikkadavu Via Shanamangalam colony- 4.4 Km and submit for approval of this authority. The grantee should produce current records of suitable vehicle within one month from the date of receipt of this decision failing which sanction will be revoked without further notice.**

ItemNo25

“Heard” This is an application for the grant of regular permit on the route Tholpetty - Mananthavadi (via) Aranappara, Chekadi, Appapora, Thett road, Begur palam, Kattikulam as ordinary service. Verified the records. The enquiry officer reported that the proposed route is covering remote areas and ill served places. No serious objections received against the application. **Hence fresh regular permit on the route Tholpetty- MananatNo serious objections filed against this application.Hence Regular permit on the route Tholpetty - Mananthavadi (via) Aranappara, Chekadi, Appapora, Thett road, Begur palam, Kattikulam as ordinary service is granted subject to settlement of timings and production of current records of suitable vehicle within one month from the date of receipt of this decision failing which sanction will be revoked without further notice.**

ItemNo26

“Heard.” This is an application for fresh regular permit in respect of new or suitable vehicle to operate on the Route Perikkalloor Kalpetta – Kallor – Kallumukku Via Mullankolly, Pulpally, Irulam, Chethalayam, Sulthan Bathery, Meenangadi, Muttill, Via Hospital, Edapetty, Kainatty and Moolankavu as ordinary service. Verified the records.The time schedule shows that the main intention of the applicant is operating maximum trips on the sector Sulthan Bathery-Kalpetta which is a well-served sector. There is little gap of time for further allotment. If the permit is granted it would add more congestion on the well served sector. This will create unhealthy completion and leads to road accidents. Hence **the application for fresh regular stage carriage permit is rejected.**

ItemNo27

Heard. Verified the records.This is an application for the grant of regular permit on the route Poolakundu- Kalpetta (via) Vendola, Cheeral, Madakkara, Chulliyode, Ambalavayal, 54, Meenangadi, Muttill vivekananda Hospital, Kainatty, Sultha Batheri, Pazhoor, Cheeral and Nambiarkunnu. The field officer reported that the major portion of the proposed route is on the well served sector Kalpetta to Bathery. The grant of the application leads to unhealthy competition among the operators and threat to road safety. During the meeting Represantitives of existing operators raised serious objection against this application. Hence **the application for fresh regular stage carriage permit is rejected.**

ItemNo28

“Heard “. This is an application for fresh regular stage carriage permit in respect of New or suitable stage carriage to operate on the intra-district route Mukkamkunnu- Sulthan Bathery- Pulpally- Kenichira- Kalpetta- Karappuzha Damvia Muttill, Chethalayam, Eriyappally, Kariambady, Kolavayal, Parakkal, Vivekananda Hospital, Edappetty and Kainatty as ordinary service. Verified the records. In this case the enquiry officer reported that the major portion of the route lies in the well served sector Kalpetta -Sulthan Bathery and settle time in this route leads to unhealthy competition . During the meeting several objections received against this proposal. Hence **the application for fresh regular stage carriage permit is rejected.**

ItemNo29

Applicant is absent while the matter is considered. Hence, **decision on the application for fresh regular stage carriage permit is adjourned.** Secretary shall place the application in the next meeting of RTA with due notice to the applicant, indicating the date, time and venue of the meeting.

ItemNo30

Applicant is absent while the matter is considered. Hence, **decision on the application for fresh regular stage carriage permit is adjourned.** Secretary shall place the application in the next meeting of RTA with due notice to the applicant, indicating the date, time and venue of the meeting.

ItemNo31

This is an application for fresh regular permit in respect of new or suitable vehicle to operate on the Route Kolavally - Kalpetta – Sulthan Bathery Via Seethamound, Chamappara, Madapallikunnu, Kappiset, 56th Jn, Pulpally, Eriyappally, Manalvayal, Kenichira, Kariyambadi, Muttill, Chethalayam, Parakkal and Kainatty as ordinary service. The enquiry officer reported that the proposed route is covering the remote areas of Mullankolly, Pulpally, Poothady & Muttill Panchayaths, there is no much services in the proposed route, hence new service may be beneficial to the passengers of the above area, no direct bus service from Kolavally to District Head quarter and hence this service beneficial to the employees, Students and other Passengers.

Hence **regular permit on the Route Kolavally - Kalpetta – Sulthan Bathery Via Seethamound, Chamappara, Madapallikunnu, Kappiset, 56th Jn, Pulpally, Eriyappally, Manalvayal, Kenichira, Kariyambadi, Muttill, Chethalayam, Parakkal and Kainatty as ordinary service is granted subject to settlement of timings & production of current records of suitable vehicle with in one month from the date of receipt of this decision failing which sanction will be revoked without further notice.**

ItemNo. 32

Heard. Verified the records. This is an application for the grant of fresh permit on the route Sulthan Bathery- Ambalavayal (via) Poomala, Malavayal, Ambukutty and Edakkal as ordinary service. The enquiry officer reported that the proposed route is through ill served areas. No serious objection received against this proposal. Hence **fresh permit on the route Sulthan Bathery- Ambalavayal (via) Poomala, Malavayal, Ambukutty and Edakkal as ordinary service granted subject to settlement of timings & production of current records of suitable vehicle with in one month from the date of receipt of this decision failing which sanction will be revoked without further notice.**

ItemNo. 33

“Heard”. Verified the records. This is an application for fresh regular stage carriage permit in respect of New or suitable stage carriage to operate on the intra-district route **Irulam- Kenichira** via Angadyssery, Parappanangady, Kolery as ordinary service. The enquiry officer reported that the proposed route is beneficial to the passengers from Irulam to Kenichria (via) Angadiserry, Parappangady, Koleri. No serious objection received against this application. **Hence fresh regular stage carriage permit on the route Irulam- Kenichiravia Angadyssery, Parappanangady, Kolery as ordinary service is granted subject to settlement of timings & production of current records of suitable vehicle with in one month from the date of receipt of this decision failing which sanction will be revoked without further notice.**

Item No.34

“Heard”. Verified the records. This is an application for the grant of fresh permit on the route Sulthan Bathery- DM Wims Medical college via Kolagappara, Ambalavayal, Vaduvanchal and Arepatttaas ordinary service. The enquiry officer reported that the proposed route is not served by sufficient number of services. No serious objection received against this application. **Hence fresh permit on the route Sulthan Bathery- DM Wims Medical college via Kolagappara, Ambalavayal, Vaduvanchal and Arepattta as ordinary service is granted subject to settlement of timings & production of current records of suitable vehicle with in one month from the date of receipt of this decision failing which sanction will be revoked without further notice.**

Item No.35

“Heard”. Verified the records. This is an application for fresh regular stage carriage permit in respect of New or suitable stage carriage to operate on the intra-district route **Sulthan Bathery- DM WIMS Medical College** via Kolagappara, Ambalavayal, Vaduvanchal and Areppetta as ordinary service. As per the enquiry report, the proposed route is beneficial to the people of the rural areas of Pulpally, Poothady, Panamaram and Mullankolly panchayaths. But on verification of the time schedule only single trip is provided to Marakkadavu. During the meeting request received for more trips to Marakkadavu. On receipt of such a proposal from the applicant, the secretary, shall conduct an enquiry regarding its feasibility and place the matter before this authority for reconsideration. **For the compliance of the above directions, the decision on the application is adjourned.**

ItemNo 36

“Heard.” Verified the application. This is an application for fresh regular permit in respect of new or suitable vehicle to operate on the Route Niravilpuzha – Valad – Mananthavady Via Kunhome, Karimbil, Korome, Makkiyad, Thettamala and Moolithode as ordinary service. As per the enquiry report, the proposed route Niravil puzha- Valad- Mananthavadi (via) Kunhme, Karimbil, Korom, Makkiyad, Thettamala and Moolithodu will cater to the travelling needs of people in remote villages. No serious objection received against this application. **Hence fresh regular permit in respect of new or suitable vehicle to operate on the Route Niravilpuzha – Valad – Mananthavady Via Kunhome, Karimbil, Korome, Makkiyad, Thettamala and Moolithode as ordinary service or is granted subject to settlement of timings & production of current records of suitable vehicle with in one month from the date of receipt of this decision failing which sanction will be revoked without further notice.**

ItemNo 37

No serious objections received against the application.

Hence **regular permit granted on the routeThirunelly - Mananthavady via Ashramam School, Pothumoola, Panavally and Kattikulamas ordinary service, subject to settlement of timings and production of suitable vehicle with in one month from the date of receipt of this decision failing which sanction will be revoked without further notice.**

Item No. 72

Heard. This is an application for fresh regular permit on the route Panamaram- Meenangady- Moonanakkuzhi via Cheekkalloor, Koodothummam, Varadoor, Vet Hospital, Kariambady and Appad as ordinary service. Enquiry officer reported that the route is beneficial to the

Hence **regular permit granted on the route Panamaram- Meenangady via Cheekkalloor, Koodothummam, Varadoor, Vet Hospital and Kariambadyas ordinary service, subject to settlement of timings and production of suitable vehicle with in one month from the date of receipt of this decision failing which sanction will be revoked without further notice.**

Item No. 83

Heard. This is an application for fresh regular permit on the route Mukkamkundu- Meenangady Via Mandad, Muttil and kakkavayalas ordinary service. Enquiry officer reported that the route is beneficial to the passengers from Mukkamkundu to Muttil it is an ill served area and portion from Muttil to Kakkavayal lies in Bathery to Kalpetta route, it is well served and to settle timing in this route may lead unhealthy competition.

This authority is of the view that granting this permit will unsettle the present state of equilibrium of timings prevailing among the stage carriage operators in the well served sectors of Bathery to Kalpetta route region and may lead to unhealthy competition between the en route operators and traffic congestion ,which in turn will harmfully affect the travelling public as well as other road users. **Hence the application for fresh regular stage carriage permit is rejected.**

Hence regular permit granted on the route Pulppally-Bavaly-Mananthavady via Vadanakkaval, Chekady,Thonikkadavu and Kattikkulam, as ordinary service with following conditions,

1.The Secretary RTA shall obtain Road Fitness certificate from PWD Authorities for the virgin portion. On receipt of such certificate fix the fare stage on the virgin portion.

2.Subject to settlement of timings, and production of suitable vehicle with in one month from the date of receipt of this decision failing which sanction will be revoked without further notice.

Item No. 85

Enquiry officer reported that New service may be beneficial to the students and other passengers and proposed route is covering the remote areas.No serious objections received against the application .Hence **regular fresh permit granted on the route Irulam – Meenangadi -Devargada- Pulpally via Kappiset, A dikolly, 56 jn, Papplassery, Moonanakuzhy, Appadasordinary service, subject to settlement of timings and production of suitable vehicle with in one month from the date of receipt of this decision failing which sanction will be revoked without further notice.**

Item No. 86

Heard. This is an application for fresh regular permit on the route Panamaram- S Bathery- Pulpally- Mananthavady- Kalpetta via Nadavayl, Beenachi, chethalayam, irulam, Dasanakkara, Payyampally, Koilery, Pallikkal, Thonichal, 4th mile, Tharuvana, Padinharathara and Pinangode as ordinary service. Enquiry officer reported that the route is beneficial to the passengers from Pulpally, Poothadi, Edavaka and Panamaram Panchayath it is an ill served area. During the meeting the enroute oprators on the sector Kalpetta- S Bathery- Pulpally raised serious objection against the application. This authority examined the connected file and verified the enquiry reports of the field officer. Obviously, the majority of trips proposed by the applicant are in the well served sector Mananthavady-Kalpetta. Hence the Secratry RTA is directed to conduct a detailed enquiry regarding frequency of service on the applied route showing the registrarion number and timings of stage carriages before this authority for reconsideration. **For the compliance of the above directions, the decision on the application is adjourned .**

Item No. 87

Heard. This is an application for fresh regular permit on the route Kolavally- Seetamount- Pulppally via Chamappara, Madappallikkunnu, parakkadavu, Kappiset, Chettapalayam as ordinary service. Enquiry officer reported that New services may be beneficial to the students and other passengers and proposed route is covering the remote areas. No serious objections received against the application .**Hence regular permit granted on the route Kolavally- Seetamount- Pulppally via Chamappara, Madappallikkunnu, parakkadavu, Kappiset, as ordinary service, subject to settlement of timings and production of suitable vehicle with in one month from the date of receipt of this decision failing which sanction will be revoked without further notice.**

Item No. 88

Heard. This is an application for fresh regular permit on the route Kolavally- Pulppally- Sulthanbathery- Panamaram via Chamappara, Madappallikkunnu, Parakkadavu, Kappiset, Chethalayam, Veliyambam, Nadavayal, Kenichira as ordinary service. Enquiry officer reported that New services may be beneficial to the students and other passengers and proposed route is covering the remote areas. No serious objections received against the application. **Hence regular permit granted on the route Kolavally- Pulppally- Sulthanbathery- Panamaram via Chamappara, Madappallikkunnu, Parakkadavu, Kappiset, Chethalayam, Veliyambam, Nadavayal, Kenichira as ordinary service, subject to settlement of timings and production of suitable vehicle with in one month from the date of receipt of this decision failing which sanction will be revoked without further notice.**

Item No. 89

Heard. This is an application for fresh regular permit on the route Panamaram- Kambalakkad- Kottathara- Kalpetta via Vilambukandam, pallikkunnu, Vandiyambetta, thekkumthara, chooriyatta, Maniyamcode and Munderias ordinary service. Enquiry officer reported that

1. In the route Kambalakkad to Kottathara the distance from 1st mile Junction to Kallamvettippalam 2.8 Km is vrgine portion, Hence fitness certificate may be obtained from the concerned authority.
 2. Proposed route is covering the remote areas of Wayanad district.
 3. There are no many services in the proposed route, Hence new service may be beneficial to the tribals, students and other passengers.
- No serious objections received against the application .

Hence regular permit granted on the route Panamaram- Kambalakkad- Kottathara- Kalpetta via Vilambukandam, pallikkunnu, Vandiyambetta, thekkumthara, chooriyatta, Maniyamcode and Munderi as ordinary service with following conditions ,

1.The Secretary RTA shall obtain Road Fitness certificate from PWD Authorities for the virgin portion . On receipt of such certificate fix the fare stage on the virgin portion.

2. Subject to settlement of timings , and production of suitable vehicle with in one month from the date of receipt of this decision failing which sanction will be revoked without further notice.

Item No. 90

Heard. This is a request for condonation of delay in Submitting current records and obtaining the variation of permit granted by RTA on 25/6/2019 varying the route as Thaloor-Kannur by curtailing the portion from Kannur to Parassinikadavu for complying the restriction of route length to maximum 140 kms vide GO (P) No. 8/2017/Trans. In respect of S/c KL 73 A 9432 (Old Vehicle KL 12 E 8757) and renewal of permit.

“RTA Wayanad in its meeting held on 25/6/2019 vide Item No.11 considered the application for regular variation of permit in respect of S/C KL 12 B 9310 (later replaced as KL 12 E 8757) and decided as follows.

“Heard. This is an application for regular variation of permit in respect of Stage Carriage KL-12/G-3629 (Later replaced by KL-12/B-9310 & Now KL 73 A 9432) operating on the route Thaloor-Parassinikkadav Via Chulliode- Bathery, Kenichira, Nadavayal, Panamaram, Koilery, Mananthavady, Chandanathode, Nedumpoyil, Koothuparamba, ThazheChovva, Kannur, Dharmasala as LSOS. This is an application for variation by curtailing the route portion Kannur to Parassinikkadavu so as to conduct service on the route as Thaloor-Kannur Via Chulliode- Bathery, Kenichira, Nadavayal, Panamaram, Koilery, Mananthavady, Chandanathode, Nedumpoil, Kuthuparamba, Mambaram, Chala, ThazheChovva as LSOS. The variation requested is for complying the Restriction of route length to maximum 140 Kms vide GO(P) No.08/2017/Tran dated 23/03/2017. Hence variation of permit granted, subject to settlement of timings.” It is reported by Secretary RTA that the grantee did not produced the current records of the vehicle. Hence variation not endorsed. Though the applicant has submitted a request to condone the delay he has not produced any valid proof in support of his claim. This authority is not convinced that the applicant was prevented by good and sufficient reasons from producing the records of the vehicle in time. Hence, the decision on the condonation of delay in Submitting current records and obtaining the variation of permit granted by RTA on 25/6/2019 varying the route as Thaloor-Kannur by curtailing the portion from Kannur to Parassinikadavu is adjourned, with direction to the applicant to produce any supporting document to consider the request for delay condonation. In the case of renewal permit application , the Secretary RTA is directed to conduct enquiry in the light of the G O (p) No 13/2023 dated. **For the reasons above, the decision on the application for renewal of permit is adjourned.**

Item No- 91

Heard. This is an application for variation of permit in respect of stage carriage KL 73 C 9854 authorised to operate on the intradistrict route - Nambiarkunnu-Thaloor, (Via) Nambiarkunnu School, Kudukki, Cheeral, Pazhoor, Puthenkunnu, Block Office, Chungam, SulthanBathery, Ammayipalam, Malankara, Madakkara, Mangalamkarp and Chulliyode. The proposed variation is for: Curtailing portion from Nambiarkunnu to SulthanBathery ,changing halting place from Cheeral to Thaloor. The enquiry officer reported that 1.The curtailing portion is well served will not affect the traveling public adversely 2. There is adequate travelling facility for the passengers between SulthanBathery to Thaloor. The existing route length reduced from 33 KM to 14 KM (57%). During the meeting several objections received against the proposed withdrawal of service from ill-served portions filed by the travelling public (especially students' community) and people's representatives.

The above application was considered in the RTA dated 22/06/2022 vide item no. 9 and took decision as "*Heard. This is an application for variation of permit so as to curtail the portion from Nambiarkunnu to SulthanBathery and changing the halting place from Cheeral to Thaloor. The necessity for changing the halting place and curtailment of the portion of the route not reported by the Secretary RTA. Secretary RTA shall conduct a detailed enquiry on this aspect and submit the application before the next RTA along with the report. Adjourned.*"

As per the decision of RTA dated 22/06/2022 detailed enquiry conducted through MVI and revealed that the application is not Complying Rule (6)I,ii and (7) ii of Rule 145 of KMVR 1989. *Furthur it is noted that in the guise of variation more or less there is a total change in the timings. Hence **rejected***".

Item No-92

Applicant is absent while the matter is considered. **Hence, decision on the application for fresh regular stage carriage permit is adjourned.** Secretary shall place the application in the next meeting of RTA with due notice to the applicant, indicating the date, time and venue of the meeting.

Item No: 93

Heard. Perused the records. This is an application for the grant of variation of permit in respect of stage carriage KL 12 F 0090 permitted on the route Parathode- Mananthavady via Padinjarathara, Kappundikkal, Panthipoyil, Varambatta, Vellamundu 8/4, Tharuvana and 4th mile as ordinary service. The proposed variation is by deviating the trip from Padimjarathara to Panthipoyil (via) Thongumunda in stead of Koppidi junction. The enquiry report shows that the deviation will not much affect travelling public and at the same time will be beneficial to the travelling public of the deviated portion and

there is no change in the existing timings in this case the advantages overweigh the disadvantages. **Hence the variation of permit is granted subject to settlement of timings without changing any other timings.**

Item No: 94

“Heard.” Verified the records. This is an application for the grant of variation of permit in respect of permit in respect of stage carriage KL 12M 2502 permitted on the route Vellithode-Vaduvanchal via Muttill, Kainatty, Kalpetta, Puthooravayal, Kaooankolly, Meppadiand Arapetta as ordinary service for extension of route from vellithode to Mukkamkunnu. The enquiry report reveals that the proposed variation will be beneficial to the travelling public on the extending sector and no change of timings in the existing route. **Hence, the variation is granted subject to settlement of timings and permitting to extent trip from Vellithodu to MukkamKunnu without changing any other timings.**

Item No: 95

“Heard.” Verified the records. This is an application for the renewal of inter district regular permit in respect of Stage Carriage KL 12 G 4242 operating on the route Nilambur- Thirunelly Via Edavanna, Arecode, Mukkam, ThamarasseryChungam, Adivaram, Lakkidi, Pookode, Lake, 12th bridge, Vythiri GP Jn, Chundale, Kalpetta, Mamiyancode, Pachilakkad, Panamaram, Kaithakkal, Koilery, Mananathavady, Kattikkulam and Thetturoad as Fast Passenger valid till 30/03/2015.

The permit was issued on 2001. It is a saved permit. This permit was taken over by KSRTC on 17/03/2015. KSRTC has been operating the service since then. A clearance certificate was issued on 11/04/2016 to the vehicle in obedience to the judgment of Hon'ble High Court in WP(C) 11933/2014 (N) under suspended animation. The applicant had submitted a declaration filed by the permit holder that new vehicle will be produced with in a period of 4 months. Quite quandary to the affidavit filed by the permit holder, no new vehicle was offered till recently (ie 23/11/2022). This is a violation of Judgement of Hon'ble High Court in WP(C) 11933/2014.

In this case renewal of permit and variation of permit is requested on permit which was kept in suspended animation with effect from 05/07/2016 on a declaration filed by the permit holder that new vehicle will be produced with in a period of 4 months as per the judgment of Hon'ble High Court in WP(C) 11933/2014 (N). Quite quandary to the affidavit filed by the permit holder, no new vehicle was offered till recently (ie 23/11/2022). Hence Renewal of permit and variation application are **Rejected.**

Item No: 96

Heard. Perused the records. This is an application for the grant of variation of permit in respect of stage carriage KL 12 M 0565 permitted to operate on the route Parathode- Mananthavady via 13th mile, Padinjarathara, Kuppadithara, Mundakutty Cheriyaankolly, Karakkamala, 5th mile and Thonichal by addition one trip from Padinjarathara to Mundakutty. With no change in the existing route. Since additional trip proposed will be beneficial to the travelling public, **the variation of permit is granted subject to settlement of timings and permitting extend the trip from Padinjarathara to Mundakutty without changing any other timings.**

Item No: 97
