S.R.O.No...../2013.- In exercise of the powers conferred by section 111 of the Motor Vehicles Act,1988 (Central Act 59 of 1988), the Government of Kerala hereby make the following rules further to amend the Kerala Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989, the same having been previously published as notification No.5155/B1/2012/Tran. dated the 16th October, 2012 in the Kerala Gazette Extraordinary No.973 dated the 20th October, 2012 as required by sub-section (1) of section 212 of the said Act, namely:-

RULES

1. Short title and commencement .-- (1) These rules may be called the Kerala Motor Vehicles (Second Amendment) Rules, 2013.

(2) They shall come into force at once.

2. Amendment to the Rules.- In the Kerala Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989, in rule 269, in sub-rule (9), for the words "ten percent" at both the places where they occur, the words "twenty percent" shall be substituted.

Explanatory Note

(This does not form part of the notification, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

The Committee on the Welfare of Senior Citizens of the Kerala Legislative Assembly (2011-14) recommended the Government to reserve ten percent seats each for senior citizen gents and senior citizen ladies travelling in stage carriages. Government have considered the recommendations and have decided to reserve twenty per cent of the seats in all ordinary and limited stop ordinary stage carriages, for senior citizens and out of that twenty percent of the seats one half each shall be provided for senior citizen gents and senior citizen ladies. For the implementation of the above decision, the Kerala Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989, have to be amended. Government have decided to amend the said Rules accordingly.

The notification is intended to achieve the above object.
