DRAFT RULES

1. *Short title and commencement* .- (1) These rules may be called the Kerala Motor Vehicles (.....Amendment) Rules, 2022.

(2) They shall come into force at once.

2. *Amendment of the Rules* .- In the Kerala Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989, in sub-rule (3) of rule 260A, for the words "fifteen years" the words "seventeen years" shall be substituted.
