ORDER

The Motor Vehicles Department has commissioned the first phase of project for Automation of Enforcement Wing. The objective of this project is to enhance Road Safety by enforcing Motor Vehicles rules and regulations using speed cameras and radar surveillance systems. Administrative Sanction for installation of Radar Surveillance System in connection with Enforcement Automation System with financial assistance of Central Government, has been accorded vide Government Order read as 1st paper above. As part of the Enforcement Automation Project 75 number of PDA(Personal Digital Assistant) devices have been supplied to the enforcement wing of Motor Vehicles Department and the field officers are equipped with the PDA device for fetching vehicle/ Driving License data from department data base and for preparation of check reports at the time of checking of vehicles. A fee receipt/ chelan also can be generated by the PDA device for collecting compounding

fee in place of TR5 receipt prescribed under Kerala Financial Code. Transport Commissioner in his letter read above has requested to accord sanction for issuing PDA device generated chelan in place of 'TR5' receipts issued manually.

Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to accord sanction to the Transport Commissioner for issuing PDA device generated chelan in place of 'TR5' receipts issued manually on condition that, necessary safeguard should be taken to remit full amount collected from the public and that must be remitted to Government account in time. The existing rules relating to receipts by way of conventional 'TR5' receipts, shall be applicable to PDA device generated receipts also without any modification.


