Explanatory Note

(This does not form part of the Notification, but is intended to bring out its main purport.)

Inter-state Road Transport between the States of Kerala and Tamil Nadu is regulated by the Inter-state Reciprocal Agreement executed by both the States with effect from 1-7-1976. As per clause VIII of the agreekient, any clause in that agreement or its appendix may be amended or new one added to it at any stage, only after mutual agreement between the State Governments. Both these State Governments felt the necessity for operations of new routes, extension of existing routes and operation of additional services in respect of State, Carriages, Goods Carriages on inter-state routes. The proposal to enter into an agreement between the States of Kerala and Tamil Nadu has been published under Notification No. 40398/B2/97/Tran. dated the 9th February, 1998 in the Kerala Gazette Extraordinary No. 309 dated the 13th February, 1998 and under Notification G.O.(Ms.) 335/Home and G.O.(Ms.) No: 336/Home dated the 21st March, 1998. Accordingly both State Governments have executed a supplementary agreement for the above purpose. Now, the Agreement has to be published as provided in sub-section (6) of section 88 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (Central Act 59 of 1988) and hence this Notification.

Explanatory Note

(This does not form part of the Notification, but is intended to bring out main purport.)

Inter-state Road Transport between the States of Kerala and Tamil Nadu is regulated by the Inter-state Reciprocal Agreement executed by both the States with effect from 1-7-1976. As per clause VIII of the agreement any clause in that agreement or its appendix may be amended or new one added to it at any stage, only after mutual agreement between the State Governments. Both these State Governments felt the necessity for operations of new routes, extension of existing routes and operation of additional services in respect of Stage Carriages, Goods Carriages on Inter-state routes. The proposal to enter into an agreement between the States of Kerala and Tamil Nadu has been published under Notification No. 7465/B2/2007/Tran. dated 3rd January, 2008, in the Kerala Gazette Extraordinary No. 43 dated the 4th January, 2008. Accordingly above purpose. Now, the Agreement has to be published as provided in subsection (6) of section 88 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (Central Act 59 of 1988) and hence this notification.

AND WHEREAS, the Government of Kerala and Government of Tamil Nadu have agreed to enter into a further supplementary agreement under section 88 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (Central Act 59 of 1988) for the purpose of operation of Stage Carriages on certain new inter-state routes;

Now, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (5) of section 88 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (Central Act 59 of 1988), the Government of Kerala hereby publish the following draft supplemental inter-state agreement to be entered into between the Government of Kerala and Government of Tamil Nadu, as required by the said sub-section for information of all persons likely to be affected thereby and notice hereby given that the draft supplemental agreement will be taken up for consideration at 11 a. m. on the 5th June, 2018 by the Principal Secretary to Government, Transport Department at Thiruvananthapuram and that any objection or suggestion that may be received from any person in respect of the said draft within 30 days from the date of publication of this notification in the Gazette shall also be considered by him.

Objections or suggestions, if any in duplicate, shall be addressed to the Principal Secretary to Government, Transport Department, Government Secretariat, Thiruvananthapuram within the stipulated time.

SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT No. 8

This agreement is made on this the 27th day of February Two Thousand and Eighteen (2018) between the Governor of Kerala (hereinafter called the "Government of Kerala" which expression shall where the context so admits, includes his successors in office) on the one part and the Governor of Tamil Nadu (hereinafter called the "Government of Tamil Nadu" which expression shall, where the context so admits, includes his successors in office) on the other part.

Subject to other conditions in the existing Inter State Agreements, it has been further agreed to by both the Governments as follows:

- The Stage Carriage services on 30 routes with 54 buses covering 8753.2 Kms. in the State of Kerala as shown in the Annexure A shall be exclusively operated by the State Transport Undertakings of State of Tamil Nadu.
- The Stage Carriage service on 49 routes with 88 buses covering 11719 Kms. in the State of Tamil Nadu as shown in the Annexure B shall be exclusively operated by the State Transport Undertaking of State of Kerala.
- 3. Variation/Modification of existing routes included in the previous Reciprocal Agreements in the State of Kerala operated by the State Transport Undertakings of Tamil Nadu on 25 routes and thereby increasing 48.4 Kms. in the State of Kerala is shown in Annexure C.
- Variation/Modification of existing routes included in the previous Reciprocal Agreements in the State of Tamil Nadu operated by the State Transport Undertakings of Kerala on 13 routes and thereby reducing 2854 Kms. in the State of Tamil Nadu is shown in Annexure D.
- 5. Details of additional services to be operated by the State Transport Undertakings of Tamil Nadu in connection with different fairs and festivals during every year is shown in Annexure E.

- 6. Details of additional services to be operated by the State Transport Undertakings of Kerala in connection with different fairs and festivals during every year is shown in Annexure F.
- 7. Details of additional services to be operated by the State Transport Undertakings of Tamil Nadu during summer seasons (March 15 to June 15) during every year is shown in Annexure G.
- 8. Details of additional services to be operated by the State Transport Undertakings of Kerala during summer seasons (March 15 to June 15) during every year is shown in Annexure H.
- 9. The State Transport Undertaking of Tamil Nadu would operate additional services during weekends (Friday to Monday) in every week is shown in Annexure I.
- The State Transport Undertaking of Kerala would operate additional services during weekends (Friday to Monday) in every week is shown in Annexure J.
- 11. It is further agreed that the grant of temporary permits by the State Transport Authority of Home State for the operation of additional services during Weekends (Friday to Monday) may be considered as deemed countersignature of the State Transport Authority of reciprocating state. The details of service including Number of bus and Registration Number, Trip details are to be mutually handed over between the State Transport Undertakings prior to the starting of services.
- 12. In the event of more number of buses are to be operated exceeding the provisions in the Annexure E, F, G, H, I, J and or for any other occasion the State Transport Undertakings of both States may be permitted to operate additional services on mutual agreement. The details of routes, number of round trips, number of buses to be operated and the duration of operation may be decided by the co-ordinators of the State Transport Undertakings of both the States subject to the fulfilment of usual conditions existed in the previous agreements.
- 13. It is further agreed by the State Transport Undertakings of both the States that the accidents and consequent bus release formalities should be completed mutually by the State Transport Undertakings in the respective States and the Minor repairs/break down repairs shall also be done reciprocally on payment basis. Hence the same is also accepted in principle.
- 14. It is also agreed that the State Express Transport Corporation, Tamil Nadu Ltd, Chennai and Kerala State Road Transport Corporation, Thiruvananthapuram will be the co-ordinators for State Transport Undertakings of Tamil Nadu and Kerala respectively with regard to the Interstate Stage Carriage operation and related matters between the State of Tamil Nadu and State of Kerala.

It is agreed that the vehicles of the State Transport Undertakings covered by permits as per the terms of the final agreement would be on single point tax basis.

It is also agreed that the Government of Tamil Nadu and the Government of Kerala shall observe the statutory requirements as laid down under sub-sections (5) and (6) of section 88 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988.
