As per the Government Order read as 1st paper above, 1/3 of the posts of Junior Superintendent should be in Higher Grade in the scale of pay of ₹ 50200-105300. The sanctioned strength of Junior Superintendents in the Motor Vehicles Department are 67. As such the number of posts in the Junior superintendent (Higher Grade) is 22. At present 17 Junior Superintendents are placed in the Higher Grade, and as such there are 5 vacancies in the higher grade.
